Decision

- 1) To revise the boundary of Cridling Stubbs and Womersley parishes so that all seven properties in Hanover Green are now located in Cridling Stubbs parish rather than Womersley parish.
- 2) To ensure that the above change is included along with the other agreed

amendments of the Community Governance Review in the Selby District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order which will come into effect from 31 March 2015.

Reason for Decision

Following a resolution at the Council meeting on 9 December 2014, it was agreed to commence a consultation with all residents of Hanover Green to gather a consensus on whether they wished to be located in Cridling Stubbs or Womersley parish. It was also agreed to consult both Parish Councils on this issue. The total number of people consulted was 13. This included all 11 residents of Hanover Green and the two Parish Councils. A total of 11 responses were received resulting in a response rate of nearly 85%

The results of the consultation were as follows:

- 8 people voted to locate Hanover Green in Cridling Stubbs Parish including both Parish Councils (73% of respondents)
- 3 people voted to located Hanover Green in Womersley (27% of respondents).

From the above results, the overwhelming view of respondents was that Hanover Green should be located in Cridling Stubbs parish. It was therefore agreed to amend the boundary of both villages to reflect this change.

Alternative Options considered and rejected

The only options available were to situate Hanover Green in the parish of Cridling Stubbs or Womersley.
