<u>Additional Consultation responses received</u>

<u>Drainage (LLFA) response:</u>

Based on the submitted information and the impermeable area plan supplied the LLFA is satisfied that the points of objection have been overturned and confirm that it has no further objections to the proposed drainage design. The LLFA has reviewed the proposed conditions and supports the inclusion of conditions 18, 19 and 20 to any permission granted.

<u>Sport England</u> – Sport England withdraws its holding objection to this application subject to the attachment of a planning condition as set out in the email below:

(Condition 23 of the recommendation.)

<u>PROW</u> - There is a short length of Public Footpath in the SW corner of the site . It is a unusual dead-end route that lies just outside the application site. This should not be obstructed either temporarily or permanently. If the development will permanently affect the route, then it might be more appropriate to extinguish it under T&CPA rather than try to divert it.

National Grid – still awaited.

1 additional letter of representation, which reiterated the disappointment over the loss of the railway and urged committee to reinstate the railway as part of this application.

Additional Informatives

- Railway The applicant is encouraged to continue talk with the Secretary of the Leeds Society of Model and Experimental Engineers with regards to installing a replacement model railway facility on the application site. Any such works would require a separate planning application.
