The driver informed A.V.S. of a number of faults on the vehicles, finally on the 17th December 2016 on picking up the 16 seater minibus, (parked at S.D.E. offices, Partholme Rd) it was found to be totally saturated inside! We used the vehicle by covering the seats with bin liners and it also became apparent that one of the back seats was loose and tilting over on corners.

(continued) Bringing it to the attention to the staff at A.V.S. the manager responding by claiming there was nothing wrong, and said if it was not fit for purpose we should not have used it, with no regard for the 16 vulnerable passengers going to a party at home.
The manager continued to press our treasurer for payment of the vehicle. In January 2017, Trustees had a meeting and decided to close the club because without respect from Selby A.V.S, whose role it is to support voluntary organisations, the Trustees and volunteers felt that Selby was no longer a safe place to be running a club.
