

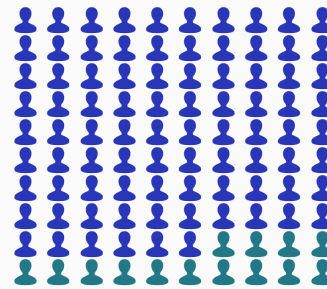


A town-wide celebration of Selby Abbey's 950th year and the heritage of the town.

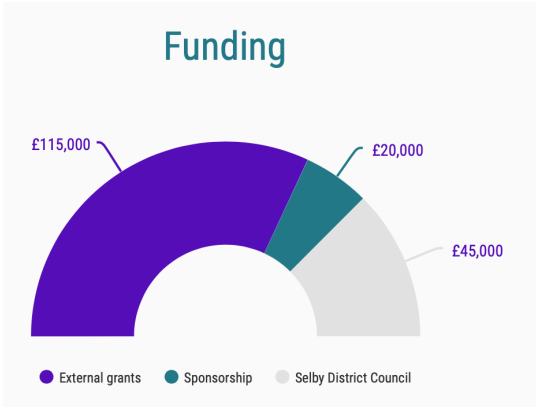
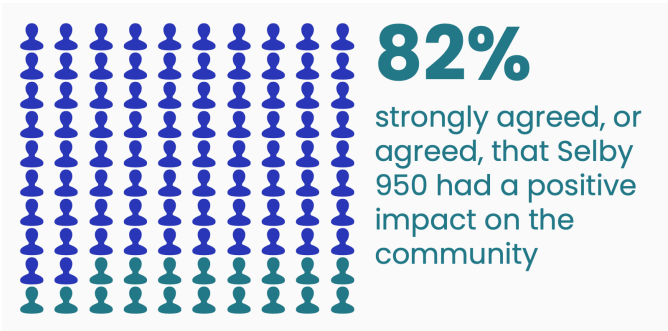
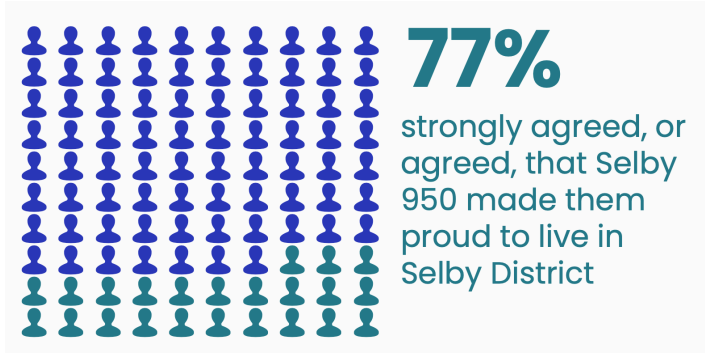
