Notice is hereby given that East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be a 30mph temporary speed restriction and to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following roads:

Phase 1: The introduction of a 30mph speed restriction on Rawcliffe Road, Airmyn during the following period:
Monday 21 June 2021 until Friday 23 July 2021 (working hours 19.00 hours until 06.00 hours - 30mph speed restriction required 24 hours a day for the duration of the works)

Phase 2: To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along Drax Road, Rawcliffe during the following period:

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure for HGVs will be via:
 Rawcliffe Road, The Green, High Street, Snath Road, Goole Road, Cowick Road, Pontefract Road, Goughall Branch, Broach Road, Weald Road, Eggborough By-pass, Eggborough By-pass to Chapel Haddesley, Chapel Haddesley to Burn, Fox Lane, Hirst Road, Main Road, Doncaster Road, Selby Bypass, Bawtry Road, Camblesforth Road, Selby Road, Camblesforth to Drax Power Station.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:
 A645 Roundabout at Drax, west along A645, then south on A1041 to Snith Road, East on A1041 and A614 Snith Road.
