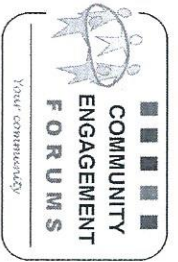

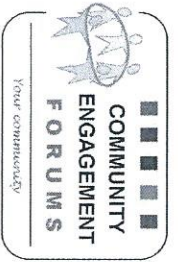


Q1 In no more than 500 words please outline the key outcomes of your project.

The work is still ongoing. As the park is on a flood zone, it was considered best to delay until the repairs and installation of the play equipment have been ordered. The items will be installed in May 2018. The CEF grant. Co-op Community Fund at a North Yorkshire County Council grant from Cllr Neil Hudson has allowed us to extend the project to include improvements to gates and bin trail path, funded through Urban Ret CF-946 (FCC Environment).

Q2 In no more than 500 words please demonstrate how the project has met the Community Development Plan objectives that were identified in the original application for funding.

The project is still ongoing. As the park land is on a flood zone, we considered it appropriate to complete all the work in one installation phase in Spring 2018. The funding from Urban Ret only approved in February 2018, so we are in the process of installing the new play equipment & replacing the dipping pond fencing prior to the installation of the new bin trail path. All works are due to commence in April / May 2018. The linked project is to improve access into the park for users of wheelchairs & double buggies. All work has been documented & is available, it requires

Over the next 3 months, we aim to complete the following improvements:

- * Install new hot water playhouse, toddler play set - (CEF funding)
- * Install new fencing around dipping pond - (CEF funding)
- * Adapt gateway & install new gate (improving access for everyone - Green Project)
- * Install new trim trail path (320 sqm) - allowing easy access to all users of the park
- * Install new 3D, tactile signage at entrance & along path (Green Project)

The aim of the improvements is to make the park more accessible to all users.
