Club Mission Statement

To provide gymnastics for all ages and abilities in a safe environment to a high standard so that the children can learn discipline and the benefits of exercise and healthy living.

About the Club

Sherburn Community Gymnastics Club was formed in 2007 with 56 members by the current head coach Amanda Alderson to provide gymnastics for all children in the local community at affordable rates. The club started training in Gymnasium of Sherburn High School. In 2011 the club expanded and opened a second operation at Barlby High School, Selby.

The club has grown over the years and now has a membership of 418 with a waiting list of 30 children. Club members are coached by 12 British Gymnastics qualified coaches. Since SCGC has moved into the new facility we have introduced 13 more classes and have given another 150 children the chance to participate Gymnastics.

Added to normal gym activities SCGC also have a display team who are coached weekly and have represented the club on events such as World Gymnaestrada Switzerland 2011, Helsinki 2015, Gynastique Magique Paris 2017, Gym Fusion 2015, 2016 & 2017 York as well as local gala's. It is planned that the display team will attend Gymnaestrada Austria in 2019. This will provide the children with a unique opportunity to show their talents on a worldwide stage.

During the last two years the club has commenced taking Gymnasts to friendly competitions at The Wire Gymnastic Club – Warrington. The competition is a floor and vault competition where approximately 15 clubs with 450+ competitors take part over two days. This gives the children a chance to compete in front of and audience and test themselves against others of a similar level.

SCGC gymnasts have won medals at all 4 competitions they have attended often out performing gymnasts who train more hours at other clubs.

The SCGC coaches have noticed dramatic development in the gymnasts since the move to the new facility and the purchase of new equipment would further and speed up further development.

In 2016 the club became a non-for profit limited company, limited by guarantee and has started the process to become a Registered Charity.

Premises

During 2016 It became clear that SCGC needed its own permanent home as the club had outgrown Sherburn and Barlby High Schools. A permanent home bringing both operations together would enable the club to grow and provide an experience for members that will be unrivalled locally. In February 2017 SCGC singed a ten-year lease on its current premises on the Sherburn Industrial Estate.

Work commenced immediately to transform the Unit from an Engineering facility to a Child friendly Gymnastics Club. All the work was carried out by Coaching staff, gymnasts, friends and family as the club does not have funds to employ local contractors.









Once all the decoration and carpeting were completed a full-size competition sprung floor and tumbling rigg was installed (at a cost of £21K requiring Head Coach Amanda Alderson to take out a personal loan to fund the purchase) along with equipment the club already had. The long-term objective is to purchase and install more competition quality equipment and training aids to enable the Gymnasts to further develop their skills. The new SCGC facility was officially opened on Saturday 4th March 2017 by Olympic Medal winning Gymnast Nile Wilson. The event was covered by local BBC News, The Selby times and The York Press.

SCGC actively encourage the coaching team to continually develop their coaching skills and further their training. All coaching staff are DBS checked and have undergone safeguarding and welfare training in line with British Gymnastics policies and are trained in first aid.

<u>Classes</u>

Classes are run for all ages and abilities regardless. SCGC have a policy of coaching the child even if that requires one to one coaching.

We currently offer 25 classes during the week, this is soon to be increased to 28 classes subject to interest.

Community

SCGC is committed to providing a safe Gymnastic environment for the local community and communities further afield. Coaches from the club have run term long gymnastics sessions at Riccall Primary School and have held a coaching workshop at Sherburn High School for the PE department.

Sherburn In Elmet has many clubs offering the usual sporting activities such as football, rugby, cricket, swimming and cycling to name but a few. SCGC offers something different that appeals mainly to girls but is open to anybody, is available all year round and is not weather dependent. The gymnasts are taught that everybody is different, they are encouraged to their ability and as part of the coaching process are taught the long-term benefits of healthy eating and physical exercise.

Many of our members live within Sherburn in Elmet and surrounding villages, but we do have members that travel from York, Goole and Castleford to attend our club all passing other more local Gymnastics Clubs on the way.

SCGC has for the last two years participated in the Sherburn Gala and this year had a float to showcase the club.

We have had two open days at the new facility which have been free to the community to come along and try gymnastics.

Funds


SCGC was created as a community gymnastics club to make it accessible to all. SCGC have a fee structure that is approximately 20% cheaper than other Gymnastics clubs around. This has its own implications, whilst trying to offer something to all it means that once all the out goings are paid there is little surplus to purchase equipment that the club desperately needs to continue to grow and be able to offer more classes and reduce waiting lists.

SCGC really does make gymnastics accessible to all, we have when required waived training fees for children whose parents were struggling financially until they were able to start payments and have offered reduced payments for families struggling to send siblings to train. The club operate a term/monthly payment scheme but if this is not practical for the family, payments on a pay as you train weekly basis have been offered.

The club has received donations from 'The Odd Fellows Arms' Sherburn In Elmet, this being their prize money from the Tug of War competition at the Sheburn Gala.

The Elmet Lions purchased a new Vault table for the club.




