Details of decision:	RESOLVED:
	To appoint Councillor Donald Mackay as a Parish Councillor for the parish of Stutton with Hazlewood in accordance with Section 91 of the Local Government Act 1972, until such time as sufficient Councillors are elected/co-opted to restore the quorum.
Reason for decision:	The Council has been advised that Stutton with Hazlewood Parish Council only elected 3 Parish Councillors out of a possible 5 in the 5.5.2022 Parish elections and 1 Councillor is unable to attend the Annual Meeting of the Council which must be held within 14 days of the start of the term, 9 May 2022.

Alternative options considered and rejected:	A Parish Council cannot function without a minimum of 3 Councillors. Section 91 of the Local Government Act 1972 provides for the District Council to appoint District Councillors to restore the quorum and enable the Parish Council to meet and co-opt to the 2 vacant seats. As Ward Member for Tadcaster, Councillor Mackay has agreed to be appointed to the Parish Council. To not appoint a Councillor – this option was rejected as the Parish Council cannot function and hold the Annual Meeting within deadline without the minimum number of councillors.

Legal, Financial or other implications:	The Local Government Act states that in a year which is a year of ordinary elections of parish councillors, the annual meeting of a parish council shall be held on, or within fourteen days after, the day on which the councillors elected at that election take office. Stutton with Hazlewood Parish Council need a minimum of 3 councillors in attendance to hold this meeting.
