Title of Decision	Staynor Hall Community Centre- S106 agreement transfer of ownership
Description/nature of matter requiring Key Decision	The report provides the Executive with an outline of the S106 agreement in relation to the transfer of the Staynor Hall Community Centre and outlines the options for future ownership and management of the centre.

Date by when Key Decision must be taken	4 August 2022
Reason why the decision cannot wait for inclusion in next Forward Plan	<p>The decision was listed on the forward plan for the required 28 days' notice, for consideration at the Executive meeting on 4 August 2022. Part of the report should have been listed on the forward plan as exempt but was not; this exemption also required the 28 days' notice. As per section 5.4 of Part 4 of Council's Constitution – Access to Information Procedure Rules:</p> <p><i>'If the date of the meeting and the urgency of the decision makes compliance with this requirement impractical, the meeting may only be held in private with the agreement of the Chair of the relevant scrutiny committee, or if there is no such person the Chairman of the Council. As soon as reasonably practicable after this permission is obtained a notice will be published setting out the reasons why the matter is urgent and cannot be reasonably delayed.'</i></p> <p>Permission of the current Chair of the Scrutiny Committee was obtained by Officers on 26 July 2022.</p> <p>The matter cannot be reasonably delayed so that transfer of ownership of the Staynor Hall Community Centre, subject to S106 agreement, can proceed.</p>
