Details of decision:	<p>RESOLVED:</p> <p>To grant £10,000 as a match against an application to the National Lottery Heritage Fund for the project “Selby Abbey: the Origins”.</p> <p>Total cost of the Development Phase is £183,027.67. At the end of the development phase (pencilled as July 2024) a submission</p>

	<p>will be made to NLHF for the Delivery Phase. Current cost of the Delivery Phase is £1,156,804.66.</p> <p>SDC intervention is 5.4% of Development Phase cost. Risk is considered minimal, as the grant is only payable if the application is successful, and the project moves to its formal development phase.</p> <p>A grant of £10,000 as a match against a total cost for the development phase of £183,027.67</p>
Reason for decision:	<p>To do so is in accordance with the legislation and Council Policy.</p> <p>The project contributes to the delivery of the Cultural Development Framework, the Visitor Economy Strategy and the Council Plan.</p> <p>The match is against very significant external investment in the District, offering a return in the region of £18 for every £1.</p>
Alternative options considered and rejected:	<p>Not offering a grant, however the likelihood of success with NLHF is greatly increased if investment from the Local Authority can be evidenced.</p>
