| Reason for | Section 85(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 states that: |
| decision: | "if a member of a Local Authority fails, throughout a period of six consecutive months from the date of their last attendance, to attend any meeting of the Authority they will, unless their failure was due to some good reason approved by the Authority before the expiry of that period, cease to be a member of the Authority" Councillor Casling has not been able to attend any Council or |
| | Committee meetings since the Planning Committee meeting on 9 May 2018 due to medical reasons. The six month period referred to above will expire on 9 November 2018 and if Councillor Casling has not attended a Council or Committee meeting before then, she would be disqualified from the office of Councillor after this date. |
