Details of decision:	The Post Office in South Milford closed on 18/07/2018. Post Office Ltd (PO) has asked the Council if they could offer the service from Grove House Community Centre, South Milford free of charge.
	The PO will pay for all set up costs to provide the service to the community. This is not a profit making venture, it will be a community service provided as part of their social commitments.
Reason for decision:	The PO will not be able to offer the service in South Milford if the Council was to charge even as a nominal fee. This is due to the POs policy of offering outreach services needing community buyin e.g. suitable premises to operate from.
	Supporting the PO to provide this outreach service allows those living in South Milford with mobility issues to access a range of services that otherwise may be inaccessible.
Alternative options	The PO have explored other venues in the locality without success.
