Details of decision:	In response to the COVID-19 outbreak the UK was placed in lockdown, across the country businesses have been required to close and residents stay at home for all but essential travel. This has had a significant impact on businesses.
	Selby provides 30 occupied retail, commercial and industrial units, leased by 24 businesses. Relief will be provided through the Business Rate Relief Scheme and the businesses may be eligible for the small business grant scheme. This is helping some businesses with the impact of the lock down.

	A number of tenants of the Council's Units have requested additional assistance through a rent-free period. The impact on the businesses during the Covid-19 lockdown is
	that 23 of the 24 are closed. The Units which are open are supplying directly to the NHS and are in lockdown for other customers.
	In response to this the Council will offer support to the businesses renting units from the Council by providing a 12-week rent free period.
	This decision is urgent, due to putting in place arrangements for Covid-19.
	The Leader agrees that the Council will implement a 12-week rent free period for Council owned retail, commercial and industrial units from 1 April 2020 to 27 June 2020 to support businesses affected by COVID-19.
Reason for decision:	In the face of the global pandemic it is essential that businesses are supported during this viral outbreak.

Legal, Financial	The estimated loss of income from the Council's commercial and
or other implications:	industrial units will be £40,369.
	This is intended to be a blanket waiver due to the relatively low- cost implications for the Council and the urgency involved in providing support to businesses in need, which means that a meaningful and timely financial assessment of individual businesses is not practicable.
	The financial support to the businesses is also well below state aid thresholds and therefore de minimis.

	 There is low risk of challenge to the decision, and it is considered the decision is reasonable having regard to the exceptional circumstances surrounding Covid19. It is proposed that this is funded from the Business Rates Equalisation Reserve. The Chair of the Policy Review Committee has been consulted as it is an urgent decision outside of the Budget and Policy Framework. He agrees that it is urgent.
	As the decision is made under urgency powers it is not subject to call-in. The Chief Executive confirms that the decision proposed is reasonable in all the circumstances and is to be treated as urgent.
