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Reason for decision:	To administer the government's Discretionary Business Grant Fund to assist businesses affected by Covid-19.

Legal, Financial or other implications:	The scheme is being fully funded by the Government and will be administered by local authorities. A Section 31 grant payment will be made to local authorities and Selby District Council will receive £876,750 in funding from MHCLG for the extended scheme.  Fully documented decisions by officers of how the grant scheme is applied will be made to ensure scheme criteria requirements are met. Local authorities are required to report weekly to central government the numbers and value of grants that have been issued. This report will be submitted using the DELTA system.  The decision is within the Budget and Policy Framework and therefore there is no requirement to consult the Chair of Policy. It is a key decision and the Chair of Scrutiny Committee agrees that the matter is urgent due to the Covid-19 impact.  As the decision is made under urgency powers it is not subject to call-in. The Chief Executive confirms that the decision proposed is reasonable in all the circumstances and is to be treated as urgent.
